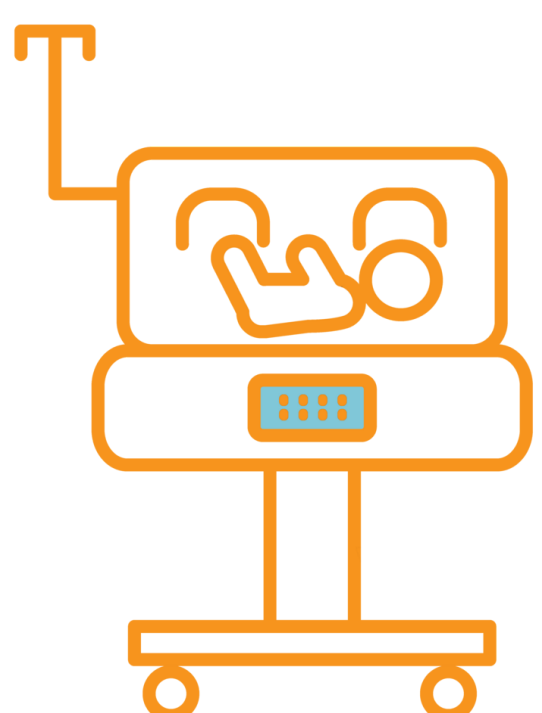
22 delivery rooms to be equipped to ensure safe deliveries for the estimated
